The Houghton Library, en la Universidad de Harvard, posee una colección de manuscritos de variada temática, procedencia, datación y estado de conservación. Hasta no hace mucho tiempo, la única descripción y catalogación de que se disponía era la de Seymour de Ricci¹, quien da igualmente cuenta de otras colecciones de manuscritos custodiados en Cambridge, Massachusetts²:

En tiempos más recientes, han sido publicados catálogos de los manuscritos depositados en los fondos bibliográficos de “The Houghton Library⁵: Indic⁶, Hebrew⁷, Syriac⁸, and Persian languages⁹”.

El catálogo de manuscritos latinos de The Houghton Library ha visto ya su primera edición con la publicación del libro de Laura Light, en el que ha dado cuenta de ochenta documentos¹⁰. Anteriormente, con motivo de una exposición de los manuscritos bíblicos del siglo XII, pertenecientes a The Houghton Library, Rodney G. Dennis presentó una serie de manuscritos no bíblicos, igualmente del siglo XII, conservados en la mencionada biblioteca de Harvard¹¹. Hemos tratado de conocer
